DUFFY NULL PHENOTYPE

 The Duffy-null phenotype is found in 10% of people in the US but it's often misunderstood, leading to inappropriate dose modifications, unnecessary procedures, and exclusion from potentially lifesaving therapies.





CLINICAL TRIALS MISS THE MARK

- Standard ANC thresholds can wrongly exclude Duffy-null participants or mislabel them as neutropenic.
- Accounting for Duffy-null biology ensures equitable eligibility and more accurate safety data.
